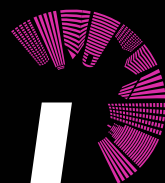

LETTER FROM DDI PRESIDENT & CEO JENNIFER SCRIPPS

In 2023, DDI celebrated a milestone anniversary. We did so by honoring our past and laying the groundwork for an even brighter future.

In our 65th year as the lead advocate for Downtown Dallas, we joined with partners to open East Quarter's Harwood Park, the fourth and final planned signature greenspace developed in partnership with the Downtown Dallas Parks Conservancy (formerly Parks for Downtown Dallas) and the Dallas Park & Recreation department. We hosted two of our biggest-ever "stroll" events, welcoming thousands of parents and children to Downtown for Halloween and Christmas events where they visited our parks and engaged with our street-level businesses. We launched our "Dedicated to Downtown" campaign to bring greater awareness to our core Public Improvement District services including Security, Clean Team, Homeless Outreach, and Ambassadors.

Downtown Dallas continues its decades-long transformation. Our \$3 billion Kay Bailey Hutchison Convention Center redevelopment is primed to transform the once sleepy southwest quadrant of the core. Ongoing office-to-residential conversion projects are putting us in the national spotlight as a model for the post-pandemic rebound. The City's \$1.2 billion bond program includes tens of millions for the Dallas Arts District, as well as critical Downtown infrastructure to spur economic development.

In 2023, we also embarked on development of our first organizational strategic plan. That work was led in part by DDI Board Chair Katy Murray, of DallasNews Corporation, and Strategic Planning Committee Chair Michael Peterson, of AT&T, and Vice Chair Billy Prewitt, of Pacific Elm Properties. Based on dozens of stakeholder interviews and focus group sessions, we drilled down on five key areas:

1. Articulate the commitment and vision of DDI, its funders, and its stakeholders, which you can see in our revised mission statement on the accompanying page.
2. Redefine and enhance "clean and safe." We are better positioned than ever before to provide enhanced services through data analytics tools that help refine our deployment strategies.
3. Plan for long-term park operations, maintenance, and strategic activations. We now manage 12 Downtown parks in partnership with Dallas Park & Recreation and the Downtown Dallas Parks Conservancy.
4. Formalize advocacy strategies and project services. We will create an easily accessible process for various audiences to engage with our team of experts.
5. Hone governance and board engagement. We will continue to work to diversity our boards and leverage the reach of our Foundation to fundraise for priority initiatives.

We hope you will take a few minutes to explore in greater detail the following pages to learn more about the work that we accomplished in partnership with you in 2023. None of it would be possible without your ongoing support and engagement. We thank you for all that you continue to do to help us build a better Downtown for all. Here's to another 65 years of progress!

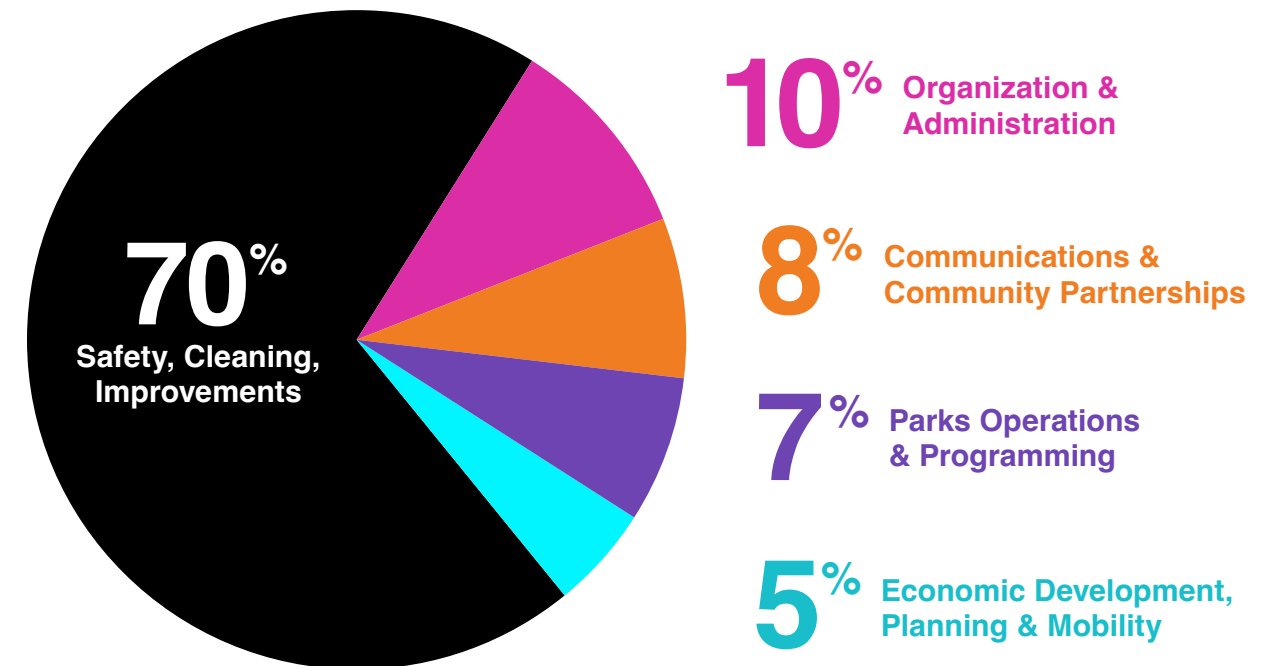

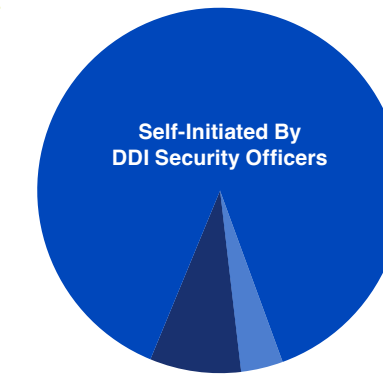
SECURITY



DDI Security is a team of security officers committed to ensuring public safety throughout Downtown Dallas. They operate in a supplemental role to the Dallas Police Department, responding to non-emergency tips and helping patrol the area seven days a week.

The DDI coverage area encompasses 1.46 square miles. DDI will continue to successfully enact strategies that ensure the safety and vibranc of Downtown. DDI will continue the partnerships area stakeholders, and continue to create a Downtown where there sustained economic development.

Off-Duty Dallas Police Officers began staggered weekly patrols of the City of Dallas Parks within the Central Business District to deter criminal acts and reduce the quality-of-life violations. The officers are assigned to work six-hour shifts in a two-officer capacity.

CLEAN TEAM



The DDI Clean Team is dedicated to maintaining the beauty and accessibility of streets, sidewalks and public spaces in Downtown Dallas. This team of full-time employees removes litter, graffiti, dog waste and gum, pressure-washes sidewalks, maintains trees and plants, and conducts cleaning and repairs of benches, bike racks and trash receptacles.

DDI launched a new Residential Conversions Tour, and added updated photography and more sites to our virtual tour tool **Vistry**.

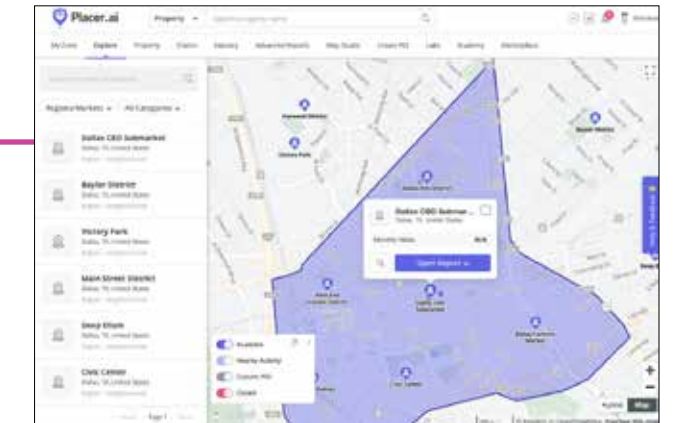

DDI participated in several transformative planning projects, including:

- ▶ Inspire Dallas Chosen as Project Manager for Renovation of the Kay Bailey Hutchison Convention Center
- ▶ I-345 trench option approved by City Council with a resolution including guidance from the DDI Mobility Committee.
- ▶ I-30 reconstruction advances decking opportunities at the Convention Center and Old City Park reflecting years of stakeholder conversations, and key Catalytic Development Area goals of the 360 Plan
- ▶ Scooters returned to Downtown Dallas with new guidelines shaped by DDI input on the City Micromobility Taskforce as part of the Shared Dockless Vehicle Program
- ▶ Streetcar Central Link update briefed to City Council, with direction to advance a long term O&M financial analysis in 2024.
- ▶ Celebree School Dallas Arts District adds a high-quality educational option to Downtown
